

WEATHER ALERT & FLOOD CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS

Message Date:	Thursday, August 29, 2019
Message Time:	12:00pm
Current Conditions:	Dorian is predicted to approach the east coast of Florida Sunday with high winds and enhanced rainfall on Sunday and Monday. Given the uncertainties of the track forecast, residents are encouraged to monitor information being disseminated by local news meteorologists and National Hurricane Center and be ready to take action, if required.
Instructions:	Operable discharge control structures have been opened since Wednesday, August 28, 2019 and will remain open until the storm passes. Please check storm drainage/swale areas and clear any blockage.
More Info.	Do not walk or drive in flooded areas. Expect low lying areas like streets, sidewalks and swale to act as secondary detention area for storm water. Move cars to higher ground to avoid flooding. Call 911 for life threatening emergencies.
